
Fr. Pat has helped us regularly with weekday Masses, helping us weekly at the New England Club, as well as with confessions during our parish penance services.

Nuestra parroquia ofrece misa en español todos los domingos a la 1:30 p.m.

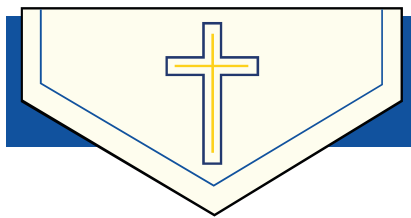

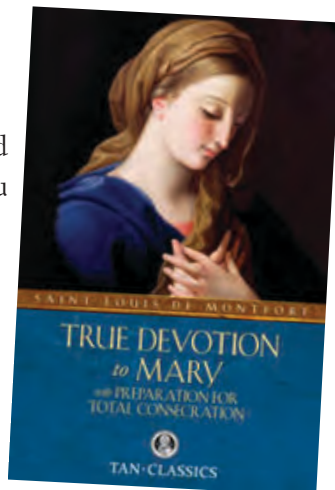
True Devotion to Mary

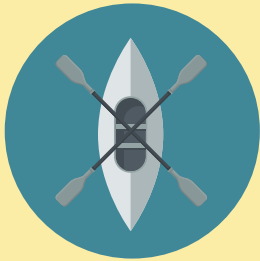

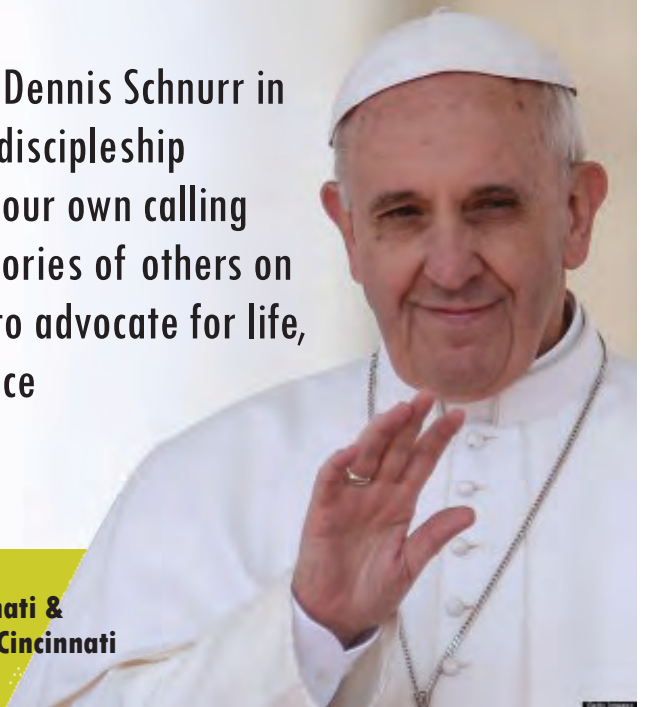

Sherry Ritzenthaler:

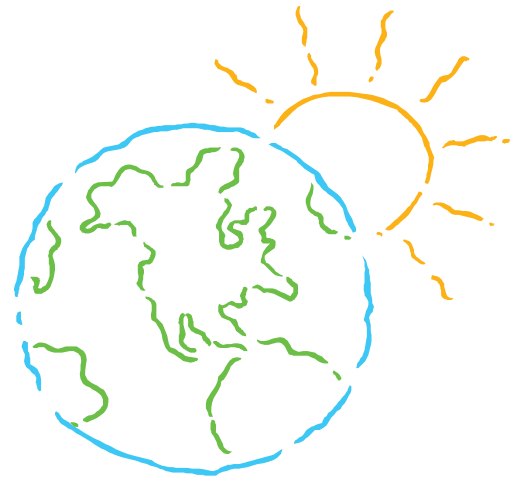
Sue Keefe starts off the initial meeting pre-Nicaragua trip with, "We are not building houses, we are building relationships." Nothing could be closer to the truth than these words. From CCBN to the Fabretto Center in Ocotal and even walking down the streets of town, the beauty of the people and the warmth is unprecedented. In the spirit of these people, the face of Christ was witnessed time and time again. I go home from this beautiful country a person whose faith has grown and will be forever changed.

Zach Ritzenthaler:

The day before going to Nicaragua, I really didn't want to go. There was only one other person going who wasn't from McNick, as I am from Turpin. I get off the second flight too exhausted to practice my four years of Spanish with customs, still not understanding why I signed up. I didn't know why, but the Lord did. He set me up with new friends from both McNick and Nicaragua. He let me open up and enjoy an experience that is truly once in a lifetime. I can't remember the last time I made friends so easily, but it happened here. I can't remember the last time I felt so free and open-minded, but here I did. I honestly can't remember the last time I cried, but here I did. The big question in life is always, "What am I here on Earth to do? Why am I here?" That was my question in the beginning, and the Lord responded with a new answer every day. There wasn't one thing that we did that didn't have a sign, a message, something from Christ. I really didn't want to go to Nicaragua the day before, but now I never want to leave.

Christiane Hazzard:

Nicaragua has provided an experience for me that will likely stay unmatched with anything. I've seen the most generous kind-hearted interactions from the moment I arrived. I truly believe God was present in the eyes and hearts of the people at the Center. I've learned more about compassion (from people I've only known for several days) than anywhere else in my life. I feel inspired to live more simply, to give generously, but most of all to give my entire heart to the people around me. There's certainly a lot of hurt and hard times in our world; yet love is abundant and perseveres. Returning to Cincinnati, I believe I'll take home a very renewed passion for social justice and equality. Having now been exposed to God's creation both in the beautiful nature and in the genuine people, my heart is now open and ready for God's plan for me. It was in God's plan for me to be here in Nicaragua.
